

## To Enroll

- Contact the Janesville School District office if enrolling in P4J.
- Call the YWCA at (608) 752-5445 x 230 to speak to the Enrollment Specialist.
- Schedule a parent meeting prior to your child starting the program and plan to attend.
- If space is available, come into the YWCA and complete an Enrollment form and pay the enrollment fee.
- Return all enrollment papers, along with the first week's schedule and payment by the Thursday before the first week your child will attend the program. You will receive all enrollment forms at the parent meeting.

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# pre-school/P4J

## What is the pre-school/P4J program?

YWCA offers sessions for four-year-olds enrolled in the Janesville School District's free P4J program. We also offer wrap around childcare and a pre-school program for children ages 3-5 for a fee, who may not be enrolled in P4J classes.

It is the pre-school version of the YWCA's popular Before and After School Child Care, which offers on-site child care for school-age children. The pre-school/P4J Program is held at the YWCA Discovery Center, 1735 S. Washington St., Janesville.

## What activities are available?

Children choose from daily optional activities, including:

- active and quiet periods
- indoor and outdoor play
- arts and crafts
- social-emotional skills
- literacy and reading
- dramatic play
- science experiences

## Who is eligible for pre-school/P4J?

Children ages 3 & 4 are eligible to participate in the pre-school program.

Children, who are 4 years old, on or before Sept. 1 are eligible to participate in the YWCA P4J program in collaboration with the Janesville School District.



## What hours are available?

We offer P4J sessions from 8 - 11 AM and 12- 3 PM Monday through Friday when school is in session. Wrap around preschool care is available 6:30 AM – 5:00 PM. You may choose the days and times you need and a weekly rate is charged.

## Who staffs the program?

YWCA child care staff meet state requirements for certified child care providers. A DPI certified teacher teaches the P4J portion of the day (8:00-11 am & 12:00-3:00 pm).

The program is licensed by the Wisconsin Department of Health and Social Services. All staff receive in-service training, and throughout the year have opportunities to attend child care conferences. State licensing requires that the staff to child ratio be 1 to 10.

## What about when school is closed?

Our pre-school/P4J program does not operate on days school is not in session. On non-school days, we offer an all-day program to school age children (ages 4-12).

If your child is 4, s/he is welcome to attend our Non-School Day Program. Non-School Days require a separate fee.

## What about lunch?

Children bring their own nutritious sack lunch to the program and can bring in items that need to be warmed up in a microwave. A nutritious snack is served in the morning and afternoon.

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## Fees

We offer "Wrap around care" which has an enrollment fee of \$100 per child (\$60 additional children). The weekly cost is \$150 (up to 30 hours) or \$250 (up to 50 hours).

Schedules and payments are submitted on Thursdays for the following week. A child must be using the program weekly. For parents choosing to have their child enrolled in the P4J program, the child must attend all days the program is offered.

## A fee is not charged during the P4J classes.

Financial assistance is available to families whose household size and income level meet the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction guidelines or others who are experiencing temporary financial hardships. Child care assistance also accepted through the WI Shares program.
